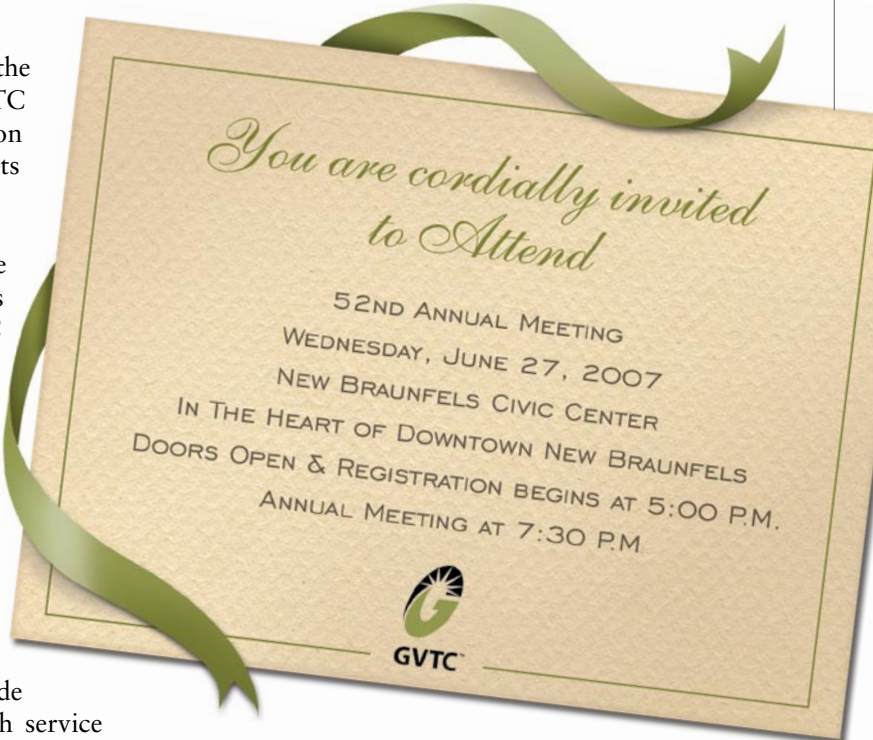
GVTC Returns Over \$4.8 Million To Members

On Wednesday, June 27, 2007, at the New Braunfels Civic Center, GVTC will distribute over \$4.8 million dollars in capital credits to its membership.

“It is a pleasure to announce the distribution of millions of dollars in capital credits to the GVTC membership,” says Ritchie Sorrells, GVTC President and CEO. “The GVTC Board of Directors voted unanimously for this year’s allocation. To date, including the sum of this year’s checks, the total membership allotments for the past 32 years represent over \$71,900,000 in capital credits.”

This year’s distribution will be made to those active memberships with service during the years of 1989 through 2005. Capital credit checks may be collected prior to the start of the meeting, during the hours of 5:00 P.M. to 7:30 P.M. To collect a check during these hours, members must present a copy of their Annual Meeting Notice and be verified as having working GVTC telephone service. #054029 Capital credit checks will only be released to the person whose name appears on the membership account.

Capital credit checks will not be available to members at the annual meeting on accounts with a past due balance as of May 17, 2007. The credit will be applied towards any unpaid balance.



For those members not attending the meeting, the remaining 47,000 checks will be mailed after the first week in July. This is the same mailing period for memberships without active service. Capital credit checks are not available at any GVTC location.

Chairman Charles J. Knibbe will deliver the key note address at this year’s meeting. Members in attendance will receive small gift bags, refreshments, and may participate in cash drawings with prizes totaling two thousand dollars. ■
