

CUSTOMER NOTICE

Guadalupe Valley Telephone Cooperative, Inc. (GVTC) has filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) seeking approval to modify rates in all the Cooperative's exchanges. GVTC proposes to increase residential access line rates in all of its exchanges and increase business access line rates in certain exchanges. GVTC's application has been assigned Project No. 37615.

The proposed rate modifications apply to residential and business customers in all of GVTC's exchanges. The proposed effective date for the new rates is February 1, 2010. The estimated intrastate gross annual revenue impact to GVTC is an increase of \$339,552.

The proposed modified rates are as follows:

If the Commission receives protest(s) regarding this proposal from 5% of the affected local service customers to which this proposal applies, by January 15, 2010, the application will be docketed. The 5% limitation will be calculated based upon the total number of customers of record as of the calendar month preceding the Commission's receipt of the protest(s). As of September 29, 2009, the 5% limitation equated to 1,575 customers.
