

The board members of KAPRA met on January 15, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. at the home of John Allen. The KAPRA business meeting was held with members in attendance including Wade Lively (chairman), John Allen, and John Hall. Connie White (treasurer) also attended. Larry Miller and Vic White were absent. Bonnie DeWind acted as secretary. The previous minutes were approved as recorded by John Allen, seconded by John Hall.

Agenda items were as follows:

Old Business:

1. John Allen reported TruGreen had agreed to spray for weeds on a "as need" basis, but recently performed a application of weed control in the runway areas. The bill for the cost of the application is \$259.20. John Allen called and discussed the "as need" services with TruGreen, and TruGreen agreed to come to Kestrel if and only if John Allen personally called their company. The Board agreed to give Connie White the bill to pay for the TruGreen service this time. It was also estimated that TruGreen would only need to apply weed control once a year, given the drought conditions we often experience.
2. The cost of KAPRA dues was discussed. John Allen made a motion to keep the cost of the dues at \$245 for 2010. John Hall seconded the motion, which was approved.

New Business:

1. A KAPRA Fly-In/Barbeque is scheduled for Saturday, July 17<sup>th</sup>, with a time similar to the one in 2009 (from 10 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.) John Hall's generously agreed to use his hangar/area. Inviting other regional flyers will be encouraged. John Allen shared his notes for ideas on this year's Fly-In: prizes, raffle, radio personality broadcast, future swap meet.
2. Water Erosion: Floyd Wilkes and John Allen have been addressing the minor erosion problems occurring on the taxiway.

The next KAPRA board meeting will be on March 5, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. at Vic White's house.

After a motion by John Allen and a second by John Hall, the meeting was adjourned at 6:35 p.m.
