

The board members of KAPRA met on March 12, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. at the home of Vic and Connie White. The KAPRA business meeting was held with members in attendance including Wade Lively (chairman), John Allen, Vic White, and John Hall. Connie White (treasurer) also attended. Larry Miller was absent. Bonnie DeWind acted as secretary. The previous minutes were approved as recorded by John Allen, seconded by John Hall.

Agenda items were as follows:

Old Business:

1. A KAPRA Fly-In/Barbeque is scheduled for Saturday, July 17<sup>th</sup>, with a time similar to the one in 2009 (from 10 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.). The location will be at John Hall's hangar/area.

  - b. Vic requested previous KAPRA Fly-In pictures from John Allen. Vic will use the pictures to create this year's Fly-In advertisement/flyer.
  - c. John Allen will start talking to members and begin putting together a committee for the Fly-In.
  - d. The board will work on a parking plan for this year along with getting another person and mule to assist with the parking.
  - e. John Allen reported that he sees that the previous erosion problem on the runway/taxiway area is improving with the repairs that have been done.

New Business:

1. John Allen reported that he is getting low on runway light bulbs. Wade Lively is looking into building LED lights for the end of each of the runways (6 lights on each end).
2. Connie White reported that she filed the federal income tax form and no taxes needed to be paid. Connie also paid for the annual insurance (\$2320) for KAPRA, noting that the premium had increased \$100 for 2010. She is also moving the KAPRA money market account from USAA to RBFCU for convenience to her and the members.
3. The next KAPRA membership meeting was set for May 15, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. at the hangar of Jack Wallace.
4. The next KAPRA board meeting was set for June 5, 2010 at noon at the home of Wade Lively.
